CHARITABLE SERVICE

Report local court member participation in activities that support or are sponsored by the Order or one of its local courts for social, educational, religious, cultural, recreational, or fraternal purposes. Generally speaking, fraternal support involves member participation in activities necessary to maintain the local court as an organizational unit, activities undertaken for members' personal development, activities that advance one of the Order's purposes, or activities that build fellowship among members.

EVENTS

Report as a "fraternal support event" three or more local court member functions or gatherings that conduct local court business, promote fellowship among members, advance the Order's purposes, or assist local court members' personal development.

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HOURS
